Third parties pose high risk of corruption. **Services** provided by third parties need to be recorded. Make sure they comply with the laws, and perform due diligence checks

Exchanging gifts stengthens relations but may influence decisions. Unreasonable and frequent gifts, trips, meals, entertainment are prohibited

Charitable donations should not been made in order to obtain a commercial contract

Facilitation payments to public officials are prohibited, except if legally acceptable and appropriate to the service provided


